

## A Sin-Defeating Savior / 4.10.22 | Key: Question (Leader's Notes)

Icebreaker: **Describe a moment when you were wrong.**

**Can someone give a recap of what has happened in Daniel so far?**

Read Daniel 5

**What is one thing that stood out to you from our passage and/or Justin's message?**

The BIG IDEA of Daniel 5 is that you need a sin-defeating, judgment-taking Savior. **What does this mean?** (*Our sin debt is that bad, AND Jesus paid for it in full.*)

Justin gave several examples of when we reject \_\_\_\_\_ about/from God, we replace that with our own \_\_\_\_\_. **What are some examples of this in your own life?** (*Have your group fill in the blanks, i.e. acceptance, sovereignty, salvation, etc.*)

Belshazzar's sin is rejecting God and replacing him with something else. **Where are we tempted to do the same thing?** (*Marriage, career, etc.*)

Despite the danger of Daniel's circumstance before Belshazzar, Daniel speaks plainly and truthfully. **Describe a time when someone, in love, shared a hard truth with you. How did you respond?**

God declares his truth through his people, which is good news. **Why do you think people are hesitant to join this type of community?**

Judgment, in the Bible, is God choosing to exercise his perfect justice in his perfect time to fulfill his perfect purpose. **Why is this ultimately good/better news?**
