

Read Philippians 1:1-11

**Pray as a group that Philippians 1:6 would be true of your group.**

**What stood out/challenged you from Justin's sermon or these verses?**

God's Word says that one day every person on this planet and every person in this room is going to stand before the God of the universe and give an account. **On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you that you'll be considered pure and blameless at the day of Christ?**

Justin said that though we are already considered saints to God, we still allow things like condemnation to seep through our gospel-past foundation.. **Are there areas of your life that you feel condemnation for? Why do you believe it is harder to receive grace for those things than others?** *(some examples might be; inadequacies as a spouse or parent, past failure in sharing your faith, doubting the goodness of God, etc.)*

The enemy of joy in the christian life is apathy. **How do we practically eradicate apathy and replace it with Joy?**

There will be a day that everything that distracts us from the grace of God is gone. **How does knowing that reality affect how you live today?**

**What do you think God sees when he looks at you in the middle of your sin and disobedience? What kind of look do you think is on his face?** *(When God sees you, even in your sin, he sees Jesus' perfect life lived for you. He sees His son/daughter that he loves unconditionally)*
