Read Philippians 1:1-11

Pray as a group that Philippians 1:6 would be true of your group.

What stood out/challenged you from Justin's sermon or these verses?

God's Word says that one day every person on this planet and every person in this room is going to stand before the God of the universe and give an account. On a scale of 1-10, how confident are you that you'll be considered pure and blameless at the day of Christ?

Justin said that though we are already considered saints to God, we still allow things like condemnation to seep through our gospel-past foundation.. Are there areas of your life that you feel condemnation for? Why do you believe it is harder to receive grace for those things than others? (some examples might be:, inadequacies as a spouse or parent, past failure in sharing your faith, doubting the goodness of God, etc.)

The enemy of joy in the christian life is apathy. How do we practically eradicate apathy and replace it with Joy?

There will be a day that everything that distracts us from the grace of God is gone. **How does knowing that reality affect how you live today?**

What do you think God sees when he looks at you in the middle of your sin and disobedience? What kind of look do you think is on his face? (When God sees you, even in your sin, he sees Jesus' perfect life lived for you. He sees His son/daughter that he loves unconditionally)
