Freedom in Christ / 7.17.22 | Key: Question (Leader's Notes)

Icebreaker: What is your favorite fun summer activity?

Read Acts 13:13-45

What do these verses say about God/humanity? Is there anything that stood out to you from Clayton's message on Sunday?

Paul is trying to show his people that all of the Old Testament is pointing to Jesus. How do you think that the Jews of the New Testament could have been raised reading the scriptures, but "miss" Jesus? What are ways that we are tempted to "miss" Jesus now?

We believe in communicating the Gospel from every passage, at every level, to every person, for every issue. How might this help us from "missing Jesus" week in and week out?

Read verses 42 & 43 again.

After Paul preached the gospel in the synagogue, people "begged" to hear the gospel preached again. **Why do you think this is?** (Try to direct the conversation to our personal lives.)

Paul says the Gospel sets us free FROM satan, sin, and death, but it also frees us TO a right relationship with Jesus. What does it practically look like to be free from sin and free in Jesus?

The Gospel changes everything. What is one area of your life/heart that you can begin praying for Jesus to change?
