Icebreaker: **Where is your favorite place that you have traveled to or visited?**

Read Romans 10:14-15; 15:20-21

How have you experienced the command to "go"? (Look for multiple perspectives) What keeps us from going as we are commanded to?

Why does God command/desire for us to go?
