Read Exodus 20:1-2

What stood out or challenged you from Justin's sermon?

Jesus is always after heart obedience rather than mere external obedience to mere external commands. Where do you see this in the 10 Commandments?

What is the significance of it being God who spoke these words? (As verse 1 states)

Justin said that the 10 Commandments start with God initiating grace with His people. Over the course of the entire Old Testament, where do you see that to be true?

Re-read Exodus 20:1-2, **where do you see Jesus in these verses?** (Jesus is the new and better Passover Lamb, Jesus is the new and better Moses, Jesus rescues us from slavery to sin to freedom in Him).

The grace of God is something we receive, not earn. What are some ways you struggle with trying to earn God's favor?

If you never do another thing for God (never lead a Life Group, defeat that sin, live up to your potential, find success, overcome that temptation), do you trust that God's grace is sufficient for you?
