

Read Exodus 20:13

What stood out or challenged you from Justin's sermon or these verses?

As we have walked through the first six commandments:

What are some truths of who God is that have stood out? *(Leaders note of some examples: God always makes the first move with grace)*

What has God revealed to you about yourself? *(Leaders note of an example: We have more idols than we think, and they affect our vertical relationship with God and horizontal relationships with others.)*

The definition of the Hebrew word for murder means homicide/manslaughter. **Why does this commandment of murder matter to God?** *(Leaders note: look up Genesis 1:27 regarding the image of God in us)*

Is it hard for you to believe that you are loved and valued by God, and made in the image of God?

Unrighteous anger says I value something more than individuals made in the image of God. **As you reflect on anger in your life, what are things you are valuing more than the individual made in the image of God?** *(Comfort, freedom, efficiency, money, etc.)*

If we let anger fester, we won't have anger, our anger will have us. **How have you seen this be true in your own life?**
