Read Exodus 20:13

What stood out or challenged you from Justin's sermon or these verses?

As we have walked through the first six commandments:

What are some truths of who God is that have stood out? (Leaders note of some examples: God always makes the first move with grace)
What has God revealed to you about yourself? (Leaders note of an example: We have more idols than we think, and they affect our vertical relationship with God and horizontal relationships with others.)

The definition of the Hebrew word for murder means homicide/manslaughter. **Why does this commandment of murder matter to God?** (Leaders note: look up Genesis 1:27 regarding the image of God in us)

Is it hard for you to believe that you are loved and valued by God, and made in the image of God?

Unrighteous anger says I value something more than individuals made in the image of God. As you reflect on anger in your life, what are things you are valuing more than the individual made in the image of God? (Comfort, freedom, efficiency, money, etc.

If we let anger fester, we won't have anger, our anger will have us. **How have you seen this be true in your own life?**
