Justin said it's important to know who it is we are praying to. **How does David describe the God he prays to in Psalm 23?**

- *A Shepherd who provides, restores, and guides*

**As you reflect over the last few months, where God has been providing for you, restoring you or guiding you? Celebrate where you see him moving and thank Him**

The truths about our God become our truth through prayer in the valley. **Where have you seen God meet you in the valley?**

God prepares a table for us in the presence of our enemies and he anoints (*refreshes us*) our head with oil. **What is the significance of God being present with us like the Psalmist describes?**

**PRAY** for one another and:

- **Praise God for an amazing week of VBS**
  - Praise God for providing the leaders and volunteers that served
  - Praise God for the kiddos that heard the gospel everyday for four days
- **Praise God for all the ways he provides, restores and guides you**
- **Pray for Fellowship Students Summer Camp**
  - Pray that middle school and high school students become transformed by the good news of the gospel
- **Pray for those who don't know Jesus as their savior**
  - Neighbors, family members, roommates, coworkers etc.
