Optional Ice Breaker: What is the most glorious thing you have ever seen? *(This could be an event, nature, interaction, etc.)*

Read Revelation 5:1-14

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through Revelation together?

Of our 4 G's of March (A Glorious Savior, Gospel Burden, Growing Need, and a Generational Opportunity), **which one gets you most excited about being a part of?**

What is the significance of Jesus being represented as both a mighty lion and a slain lamb? What does each represent?

Why do you think John weeps in verses 3-4?

What is the scroll? Why is it so important? And why would Jesus be the only one able to open it?

How does this chapter connect to Old Testament imagery? *(Examples could include: the sacrificial system of animals, the beasts in Daniel 7, or visions into the future from Daniel 7 and Isaiah 53 may be helpful to skim).*

Encourage your group to all walk through the *Spiritual Journey* devotionals daily. It may be helpful to have a group chat to encourage one another in, send thoughts from each day of the devo, etc. If anyone in your group has questions about Fellowship Forward or the direction of FBC, point them to meetings after each service every Sunday in March in the Conference Room. Also, our staff is available to meet and talk throughout the week as well!
