Ice Breaker: 2 Truths & a Lie – Pick a few people to share 2 truths and 1 lie about themselves, and then have the rest of the group guess what the 1 lie was between the 3 things they shared.

Read John 19:28-42

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through John together?

Christ was divided so that you may become whole. **What does that mean?**

In what ways was Christ divided? What things have been "made whole" in your time of following Jesus?

Gardens are a major theme from cover to cover in the Bible. **Where do we see gardens used in the Bible? And what do the gardens represent?**

Jesus finished so that we may receive. **What things did Jesus finish?**

The things that Jesus has finished we get to receive as a gift, yet, we often try to "pay God back" for those gifts. **Why do you think that is? Why is it so hard for us as Christians to freely receive gifts from Jesus?**

One of the responses Justin laid out was that in light of His death, we do not need to run from Jesus. **How is Jesus' death and His approachability related to one another?**

The other response Justin laid out was modeled by Joseph and Nicodemus in our passage. **How do they respond after Jesus' death? What would it look like for you to have a similar response?** *(Leader Note: The 2 men respond with sacrificial worship. How may we also sacrificially worship Jesus?)*

Have a time of sharing. (i.e. Share highs/lows in this season, needs in your home/community, etc.)
