Read John 13:31-38

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through John together?

Re-read verse 35. How is our love towards others reflective of Jesus? What are the effects of Christians not loving others like Christ has loved them?

What is one action step you can (or already did) take to sacrificially love others as Christ has sacrificially loved you?
