Read John 18:1-14, 19-24

Did anything stand out either from Justin's message or reading through John together?

Justin mentioned that John wants us to know that Jesus did not lose control for a single second from this point through the resurrection. **Why is that important to note during events like this? How do you see that being true in the text?**

Why is it relevant that both the Jews and Gentiles are both coming to arrest Christ?

How does Jesus' interaction with Peter (cutting off Malchus' ear) help us understand His mission and mindset?

The people lied to themselves about Christ, and so do we. **In what ways do you lie to yourself about Christ?**

The people minimized Christ, and so do we. **In what ways do you minimize Christ?**

The people slapped Christ, and so do we. **In what ways do you slap Christ?**

Christ is the High Priest that we need. **What does it mean and what are the implications of Christ being our High Priest?**

Christ, the one that we lie about, minimize, and slap, is the same one who took on the fullness of God the Father's wrath that we deserve. That is the core of the good news of the Gospel. **How should knowing the goodness of the Gospel change the way we follow, trust, and repent to Christ?**
