Read Romans 12:9-21

In Romans 12, Paul turns from Gospel instruction to Gospel application. **Why do you** think Paul decided to instruct before giving application to the readers?

Gospel love is committed to the truth. **Describe how it could be unloving to not tell the truth.**

Jerry mentioned that hospitality is someone going from being a stranger to a part of the body of Christ. What are some ways that we can be more hospitable to people in our spheres of influence?

What is your typical response when someone opposes you or something you believe in? (Focusing on how to not avoid the difficult to love people in our life).

The way we see people encounter the love of Christ is by loving like Christ, and in order for us to love non-believers with the love of Christ, we have to have relationships with non-believers. **How can we be more intentional with relationships with people who are far from Christ? Or how can we start those relationships if we don't have them currently?**

Are there difficult people in your life that you have been avoiding or have unresolved conflict with?

Pray a prayer as a group giving permission to God to reveal relationships that are broken and to give you the strength to reconcile them.
