Humility / 3.27.22 | Key: **Question** (Leader's Notes)

Icebreaker: Describe a time when you were humbled.

Read Daniel 4:1-3, 19-22a, 28-37

What is one thing that stood out to you from our passage and/or Justin's message?

In your own words, what has happened in the book of Daniel so far? (Ask 2 or 3 people to summarize all of the events so far in Daniel.)

The BIG IDEA of Daniel 4 is that we need humility which flows from a right understanding of who we are relative to who God is. **What stands out to you from that sentence and why?**

The main points of the message on Sunday were:

- God is sovereign and we are not. (Dependence)
- God is everlasting and we are not. (Contentment)
- God is righteous and we are not. (Honesty)
- God is gracious so you have worth. (Confidence)

Based on these, how would you define biblical humility?

How do we get biblical humility? (To be captured by the truth of who Jesus is and the truth of what Jesus has done for you.)

You are so sinful that Jesus had to die for you **and** are so loved that Jesus willingly died for you. **How is this encouraging/challenging?**
