Read Psalm 84

What stood out to you from Clayton's message or the passage?

Clayton says our view of God determines how we experience prayer. **How does Psalm 84 give us a comforting view of God?**

Share your reflections from these three points and questions from the message:

- 1. God is Worthy Why is God worthy of Praise in your life?
- 2. God is Strong? Where do you need God to strengthen you?
- 3. God is Good Where do you see God's goodness in your life?

Prayer is as simple as talking to God, but it is not easy to do. **What makes prayer challenging for you?** (productivity, distraction, boredom, don't know what to say, etc)

If dependence is the goal then weakness is to our advantage. Is it hard to believe that this is true? Why?

What if you couldn't pray wrong? How much more would you pray if you knew God wanted to hear prayers regardless of the content of them?

PRAY for one another and:

- Pray for more people to experience community at Fellowship as our church grows (Acts 2:42-47).
- Pray that the vision of Fellowship would be true in Southwest Missouri. (Vision: Every person, together, following Jesus, engaged where we live, and involved around the world.)
- Pray that the Lord would build our group and the church's dependence on prayer.
