GOSPEL: (20 min)

1. The beginning of a new year is a great time to evaluate what matters most.

Philippians 1:10 CEB says: "I pray this so that you will be able to DECIDE WHAT REALLY MATTERS and so you will be sincere and blameless on the day of Christ.

The word "decide" in Koine Greek (the original language of the New Testament), is DOKIMAZO which means to test, examine and scrutinize over what is genuine and right.
