Romans 1:1 Paul, a servant (bond slave) of Christ Jesus, called (summoned with urgency) to be an apostle (a delegate, representative sent out with a message) and set apart for the gospel (The Good News) of God—

Romans 1:2 the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures

Questions to ask about verse 2:

- What is a prophet?
- Who are the prophets in the old testament?
- Where in the Bible does it tell us what those prophets said about Jesus? How do I find it?

Isaiah 53:5-6

Num 24:17

Romans 1:3 regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life was a descendant of David

Jeremiah 23:5

What is a descendant mean in Greek:

Genesis 3:15 that says And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."

Romans 1:4 and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord.

* Sometimes it helps to see how another translations orders the word.

Romans 1:4 and he was shown to be the Son of God when he was raised from the dead by the power of the Holy Spirit. [b] He is Jesus he is Christ our Lord.
