Sermon Discussion Guide for Cumberland Fellowship Church Sermon Series: Biblical Pattern (Week 5) – March 5, 2023



This guide is a supplement to the weekly sermon. We encourage families and groups to use it. When we hear God's Word, we need to do more than listen. The bible says, "Be doers of the word, not hearers only." (James 1:22) Step 1: GATHER with your family or group. Step 2: REVIEW and DISCUSS the key points and scriptures from the sermon. Step 3: PRAY for the prayer requests shared by your family or group.

DISCUSSION STARTER

Have you ever willingly paid the cost of/for something (tangible, relational, etc) for another person? You may have covered the cost of a meal or groceries for someone. You may have met a need that they were unable to fulfill. You may have accepted blame for something in order to mend a relationship. How do these kinds of actions, when done with an upright heart and without conceit, allow others to see Christ?

DIGGING DEEPER 1

Review: Hebrews 9:22; 10:1-4; 10:10-12. In order for God to dwell with and have a relationship with his children, he tells Moses sin has to be forgiven and covered. What does sin have to be covered by? (Hebrews 9:22) Was this sacrifice good enough for all sin or temporary? (Hebrews 10:1-4) What is the significance behind Christ sitting down at the right hand of God? (Hebrews 4:10-12)

DIGGING DEEPER 2

Read John1:29. What is the significance behind John referring to Jesus as the "Lamb of God"? (1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 Corinthians 5:21)

DIGGING DEEPER 3 – Break it down...

DOING THE WORD

(John 14:16-17) What can you do this week to multiply the image of God? How can you reflect who he is within your sphere of influence?
