Romans 1:1-6 Paul, a <u>servant</u> of Christ Jesus, called to be an <u>apostle</u> and <u>set apart</u> for the <u>gospel</u> of God— ² the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures ³ regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life^[a] was a descendant of David, ⁴ and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power^[b] by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord. ⁵ Through him we received grace and apostleship to call all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from^[c] faith for his name's sake. ⁶ And you also are among those Gentiles who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.

Romans 1:1 Paul, a <u>servant</u> of Christ Jesus PAUSE, called to be an <u>apostle PAUSE</u> and <u>set apart PAUSE</u> for the gospel PAUSE of God.

<u>Servant</u> - Greek word = DOULOS: which means Bond Servant.

Exodus 21:5–6 But if the slave plainly says, 'I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,' 6 then his master shall bring him to God, and he shall bring him to the door or the doorpost. And his master shall bore his ear through with an awl, and he shall be his slave forever.

<u>Called:</u> means to be summoned.

Apostle: Greek word is Apostolos - a delegate, a representative, and messenger one sent forth with orders.
