

The Word Week 2

Romans 1:1-6 Paul, a **servant** of Christ Jesus, called to be an **apostle** and **set apart** for the **gospel** of God— ²the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures ³regarding his Son, who as to his earthly life^[a] was a descendant of David, ⁴and who through the Spirit of holiness was appointed the Son of God in power^[b] by his resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord. ⁵Through him we received grace and apostleship to call all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from^[c] faith for his name's sake. ⁶And you also are among those Gentiles who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.

Romans 1:1 Paul, a **servant** of Christ Jesus **PAUSE**, called to be an **apostle** **PAUSE** and **set apart** **PAUSE** for the gospel **PAUSE** of God.

Servant - Greek word = **DOULOS**: which means **Bond Servant**.

Exodus 21:5–6 But if the slave plainly says, 'I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,' ⁶then his master shall bring him to God, and he shall bring him to the door or the doorpost. And his master shall bore his ear through with an awl, and he shall be his slave forever.

Called: means to be summoned.

Apostle: Greek word is Apostolos - a delegate, a representative, and messenger one sent forth with orders.
