- 3. The first church found "Word-based encouragement" at the center of their gatherings: yet, in many churches teaching/preaching has become less central. Why is this the case and how can we protect teaching/preaching?
- 4. If we are saved by grace through faith, then is obedience to commandments such as baptism optional? Support your answer.
- 5. Awe came upon the first church when God moved. Why do many church gatherings seem so flippant? What can protect a church and its members from this danger?
