To have rules in place, you must have a relationship with your children, otherwise rules mean nothing! In the clip you've watch, Arlene gives **8 key strategies** for better parenting :

1. Amusement – your life does not revolve around entertaining your children.
2. Parents call the shots, NOT the children.
3. Routine and boundaries provide security.
4. Bible and prayer daily.
5. Marriage FIRST.
6. Talk time – healthy food around the dinner table.
7. Love spelt T.I.M.E. with your children.
8. Launching adults – not “babying” your children.
