## 5 Day Devotional / Jonathan Cain

This five day devotional will be taking a deeper dive into the sermon from this weekend. Through Jonathan's moving story, we'll explore themes of faith, perseverance, and divine guidance, drawing spiritual lessons that can inspire our walk with Jesus.

### Day 1
