



Text: 1 Corinthians 10:6-13

Big Idea: Temptation is anything that promises satisfaction in place of obedience to God.

- The temptation is not the sin.
- You are never above temptation.
- You always have a way out.
- God is faithful.

Discussion Questions:

1. Think of times when you were tempted but did not sin. How did God provide a way out?
2. Look at temptations that are personally challenging to you. How do they play on your desires?
3. Temptation is common to everyone. (v.13) Knowing this, how has God used a community of believers to give you the ability to resist temptation? Share examples.
4. How has victory over temptation allowed you to experience Gospel power in your life? How does it humble you? Equip you to help others?
