

## Week 6

**Text:** Genesis 1:26-28, Romans 8:12-17

**Topic:** Identity

**Main Idea:** The kingdom of God provides us with a different way of thinking about our identity. Through the gospel our identity is received, not achieved. We are drawn into a royal story, it doesn't depend on circumstances. It doesn't change with trends. It doesn't come and go with seasons. At the core of our God-given identity is this profound truth: we are sons and daughters of the King.
