Text: Acts 2:1-4, 37-39; Galatians 5:16-25

Topic: Holy Spirit, Promise

Main Idea: The promise of the Holy Spirit is a promise of true life. He is our promised Advocate, filling our lives permanently with His presence and unleashing us to live out of the promises of God.

- 5. What is the difference between being led by the Spirit and being under the law? How have you seen both worked out in your life?
- 6. How have you seen the promise of the Holy Spirit in your life?
