



Text: Habakkuk 3:1-19

Big Idea: We need to learn to look up to God instead of looking at our circumstances. We do that by relying on Him, remembering who He is and rejoicing in Him.

Discussion Questions:

1. The early church was identified with fellowship and commitment to the apostles' teaching. (Acts 2:42-47) How does God use Christian fellowship to help us rely on Him? How can or does your group do that? Share examples and ideas where you might encourage each other to rely on Him.
2. Read Psalm 121. Going verse by verse, what does this psalm tell you about God? How can remembering those things encourage you to trust Him more?
3. Habakkuk reminds us of God's limitless power at work in the history of Israel. As disciples of Jesus, we are told we have the Holy Spirit working in and through us to carry out God's plan. Why is *Selah* (pausing to reflect) an important part of responding to God's Word?
