



Text: Romans 15:1-13

Big Idea: Unity is weakened by selfishness. God calls us to have a bigger view of His Kingdom.

- We must value what it means to be connected to other people.
- You fight selfishness by the work and word of Christ.
- Unity glorifies God.
- Unity displays the power of the Gospel.

Discussion Questions:

1. Think of a time when someone stronger in the faith was “bearing with you” as a weaker brother or sister in Christ. How did he/she do that? What did you learn?
2. Read John 13:12-17. What are ways we can serve each other as Jesus served?
3. When we strive for oneness in Christ, what happens to our selfish desires? How would that glorify God?
4. Romans 15:9-12 says that the promises to the Jewish patriarchs were blessings to the Gentiles as well. How did unity in Christ between Jews and Gentiles glorify God? What are some modern day examples of that unity?
