



Week 1 – Father's Day

Text: 1 Corinthians 16:13-14, 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

Topic(s): Legacy, Fathers, Love

Big Idea of the Message: In a man's zeal to stand firm in the faith, be strong, and fight the spiritual battle love cannot be left behind. Paul reminds us to do "all that you do" in love. Loving in all that we do can be a challenge; but by it not only do we DEEPEN our relationship with Christ but we represent Him well to everyone else.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. In 1 Corinthians 16, Paul details what it looks like to "act like a man". How do each of those imperatives relate to being a man?
3. Why should each of those be done in love? What would happen if each of those was not done in love?
4. 1 Corinthians 13:4-7: Paul describes the love mentioned in chapter 16. Of all the elements of love specified by Paul which gives you the greatest struggle? Where in your life are you acting like a toddler?
5. Verse 7 specifically tells us that love "endures all things". It never quits. Where/When are you most tempted to stop loving?
