

Text: Habakkuk 1:1-17

Big Idea: When we start asking God questions, we need to recognize our position is limited by our abilities, time and understanding. Eventually we will be at a loss to understand God's full plan. Regardless, when we come before Him, we wrestle faithfully with our questions, with boldness and honesty.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Why is it sometimes hard to admit we don't know or understand something? Spend a few minutes and share all the reasons that come to mind.
- 2. How does ignoring, avoiding or not acknowledging our lack of understanding lessen the depth of our relationships with other believers? Our relationship with God?
- 3. Read James 1:2-4 and 1 Peter 1:3-9. Discuss the purpose of trials. How might our view from this side of the cross make it different to wrestle faithfully than it would have been in Habakkuk's time? How can that enrich our personal testimonies/stories?
- 4. Share any closing thoughts you might have from the message.
