

Text: Galatians 5:1-15

Big Idea: Gospel transformation is different from moral reformation. Gospel transformation is centered on Jesus' redeeming work. Moral reformation depends on individual effort. Gospel transformation changes us from the inside out.

- We have been set free from [empty religion, fear] and for [freedom].
- Grace provides certainty.

- 2. How can our view of others serve as a motivation test for your actions? Your thoughts?
- 3. How have you experienced joy in celebrating in the success of others? How does a Gospel-centered perspective enable that? Do you find it easy or difficult to do?
- 4. Why do <u>you</u> pursue holiness? What are the personal implications in your life?
- 5. How would you explain why you are involved in Hill Country Bible Church (attendance, participating in activities)?
