Part 3: Going and Living

Text Used: Genesis 12:2; Psalm 67; Matthew 4:18-22; John 17:18; John 20:21; Luke 19:10; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; I Peter 3:15; John 3:17; John 7:10; Mark 5:24-34; 41-43; James 1:27; Matthew 9:37-38; Acts 1:8; Mark 10:29

God is a missional God and his intent is to have a missional people.

I will make you **fishers of men**.

How do we live a missional life?

1: Personally

2: Commonly

3: Dependently

4: Restoratively

5: Holistically

Where do we live our missional life?

- **In your world (Jerusalem and Judea)**
- **Around your world (Samaria)**
- **Beyond your world (To the ends of the earth)**

Digging Deeper

Before you start:

- Remember (*You don't have to do everything...but do something*)
 - To make some uninterrupted time for this, even if it's just 10 minutes.
 - God is wanting to engage with you and waiting for you to ask anything
 - what you heard, felt, experienced on Sunday during service and the sermon.
 - Read the passages slowly, more than once, and see if a phrase, word, or passage is sticking out.
 - Respond to that in prayer: ask God why this word is speaking to you now, use that word as a prayer prompt.

Day 1

Read: John 17:18 and 20:21

- If you want, play the worship song 'Living Hope' by *Bethel* and listen to it while you read the passage or before you read the passage. (*play it as many times as you want*)
- Pray over your 'Missions Pledge' thank God that he has given you enough to send
- Think of those verses, read them, and pray them over the places you live and work in...name all the specific individuals you can think of and apply these verse to them.

Day 2

Read: Matthew 25:35-36

- If you can play the song again and try singing along with it.
- Stop, remember, and thank God for all the people that have helped you.
- Think about these words and living *missionally*,
 - *Personally, Commonly, Dependently, Restoratively, Holistically*
- Take time and pray/consider how you can exemplify these with those around you...take time and see if God brings any ideas to your mind.

Day 3:

Read: Acts 1:8

- Play the song again and listen to the words and what they mean.
- Pick a line and make that line a prayer for a few minutes
- Ask God as you go through the next few days to remind you of them as you encounter the people you regularly interact with, think and pray that your interactions with them would be 'missional' and not coincidental
