Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened.

Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will you Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

Persistent pursuit means continual and purposeful effort in seeking God

No Stones or Serpents

God does not give bad gifts

Good Gifts

God give good gifts in abundance to those who seek Him

John 3:19; Ps 14:1-3; Rom 3:23; Eph 5:8

Ask in faith in God's presence and character—Heb 11:6

Ask in the name of Jesus John 14:12-14

Ask without doubt Jas 1:5-6

Ask according to His will 1 John 5:14-15

Ask with the right heart and motives Jas 4:3
