## When God Quits Responding to Our Prayers and Offerings Malachi 2:10-17

10 Are we not all children of the same Father? Are we not all created by the same God? Then why do we betray each other, violating the covenant of our ancestors?

11 Judah has been unfaithful, and a detestable thing has been done in Israel and in Jerusalem. The men of Judah have defiled the Lord's beloved sanctuary by marrying women who worship idols. 12 May the Lord cut off from the nation of Israel[a] every last man who has done this and yet brings an offering to the Lord of Heaven's Armies.

13 Here is another thing you do. You cover the Lord's altar with tears, weeping and groaning because he pays no attention to your offerings and doesn't accept them with pleasure. 14 You cry out, "Why doesn't the Lord accept my worship?"

### 4 REASONS WE DONT HEAR BACK FROM GOD:

- 1. We aren't listening.
- 2. <u>Selective</u> Hearing <u>Disorder</u>: We hear what we want to hear.
- 3. He isn't talking.

4. He is actively <u>opposed</u> to you because you are in active and intentional <u>rebellion</u> to Him.

I'll tell you why! Because **the Lord witnessed the vows you and your wife made** when you were young. But you have been unfaithful to her, though she remained your faithful partner, the wife of your marriage vows.

15 Didn't the Lord make you one with your wife? In body and spirit you are his. And what does he want? Godly children from your union. So guard your heart; remain loyal to the wife of your youth. 16 "For I hate divorce!" says the Lord, the God of Israel. "To divorce your wife is to overwhelm her with cruelty," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies. "So guard your heart; do not be unfaithful to your wife."

17 You have wearied the Lord with your words. "How have we wearied him?" you ask. You have wearied him by saying that all who do evil are good in the Lord's sight, and he is pleased with them. You have wearied him by asking, "Where is the God of justice?"

Faithfulness isn't commitment until <u>inconvenience</u> arise. Faithfulness is only <u>proven</u> outside of <u>convenience</u>.

There are also plenty of Scriptural justifications for <u>reconciliation</u> even when we are justified in divorcing.

**OUR CHALLENGE:** THERE IS NO UNDOING THE <u>PAST</u>. WE CANT GO BACK TO <u>PREVIOUS</u> FORKS IN THE ROAD AND RE-DO THEM. WE LIVE GOING <u>FOR-</u> <u>WARD</u>.

# WE SHOULD BE <u>FAITHFUL</u> TO SCRIPTURE, <u>DEPENDENT</u> ON GOD'S GRACE, AND <u>THIRSTY</u> FOR THE GOD'S HOLINESS IN OUR LIVES.

There are reasons why God is <u>silent</u>. If God is silent because of our <u>opposi-</u> <u>tion</u> to Him, let's <u>humble</u> ourselves and honor our God and keep <u>pressing</u> into Him.
