Altars are found in the Bible as a place of: encounter, forgiveness, worship, covenant, or intercession.

HOW TO BUILD AN ALTAR:

1. Appreciate the moments that define you.
2. Pick up the rocks that were intended to harm you.
3. Pile them up as a permanent marker.
4. Thank God that He uses what was intended to harm you to shape you.
5. Return to that altar with people you love and share with them God's goodness.
