

## 3.3.22 Unbounded: Paul's Faith from Prison (Ephesians 3:14-21) Eric Reed

<sup>14</sup> For this reason I kneel before the Father <sup>15</sup> from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named. <sup>16</sup> I pray that He may grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power in the inner man through His Spirit, <sup>17</sup> and that the Messiah may dwell in your hearts through faith.
