<sup>1</sup>Children, obey your parents as you would the Lord, because this is right. <sup>2</sup> Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with a promise, <sup>3</sup> so that it may go well with you and that you may have a long life in the land. <sup>4</sup> Fathers, don't stir up anger in your children, but bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

#### **How to Honor**

- I.Always honor them in conversation...Respect for the office is different than respect for the person
- 2. Express gratitude for how they raised you...write a letter
- 3.Don't try to change them...have boundaries
- 4.Ask them their opinion & for input on decisions...you don't have to follow it
- 5. Keep in contact regularly...this varies depending on situations
- 6.Seek to follow Christ in all you do...in the end that will bring honor to the entire family

In the United States, 23.9 million children live absent of their biological fathers. Fatherless children represent:

63% OF TEEN SUICIDES

70% OF JUVENILES IN STATE INSTITUTIONS

71% of HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUTS

75% OF CHILDREN IN CHEMICAL ABUSE CENTERS

80% OF RAPISTS

85% of youths in prison

90% OF HOMELESS AND RUNAWAY CHILDREN

<sup>5</sup> Slaves, **obey your human masters** with fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, as to Christ. 6Don't work only while being watched, in order to please men, but as slaves of Christ, do God's will from your heart. <sup>7</sup>Serve with a good attitude, as to the Lord and not to men, 8knowing that whatever good each one does, slave or free, he will receive this back from the Lord.

#### **Ephesians 6:9**

And masters, treat your slaves the same way, without threatening them, because you know that both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no favoritism with Him.




Authority is not given so that we can <u>ABUSE</u> others, but so we can <u>ASSIST</u> others to become all God has in mind for them!
