



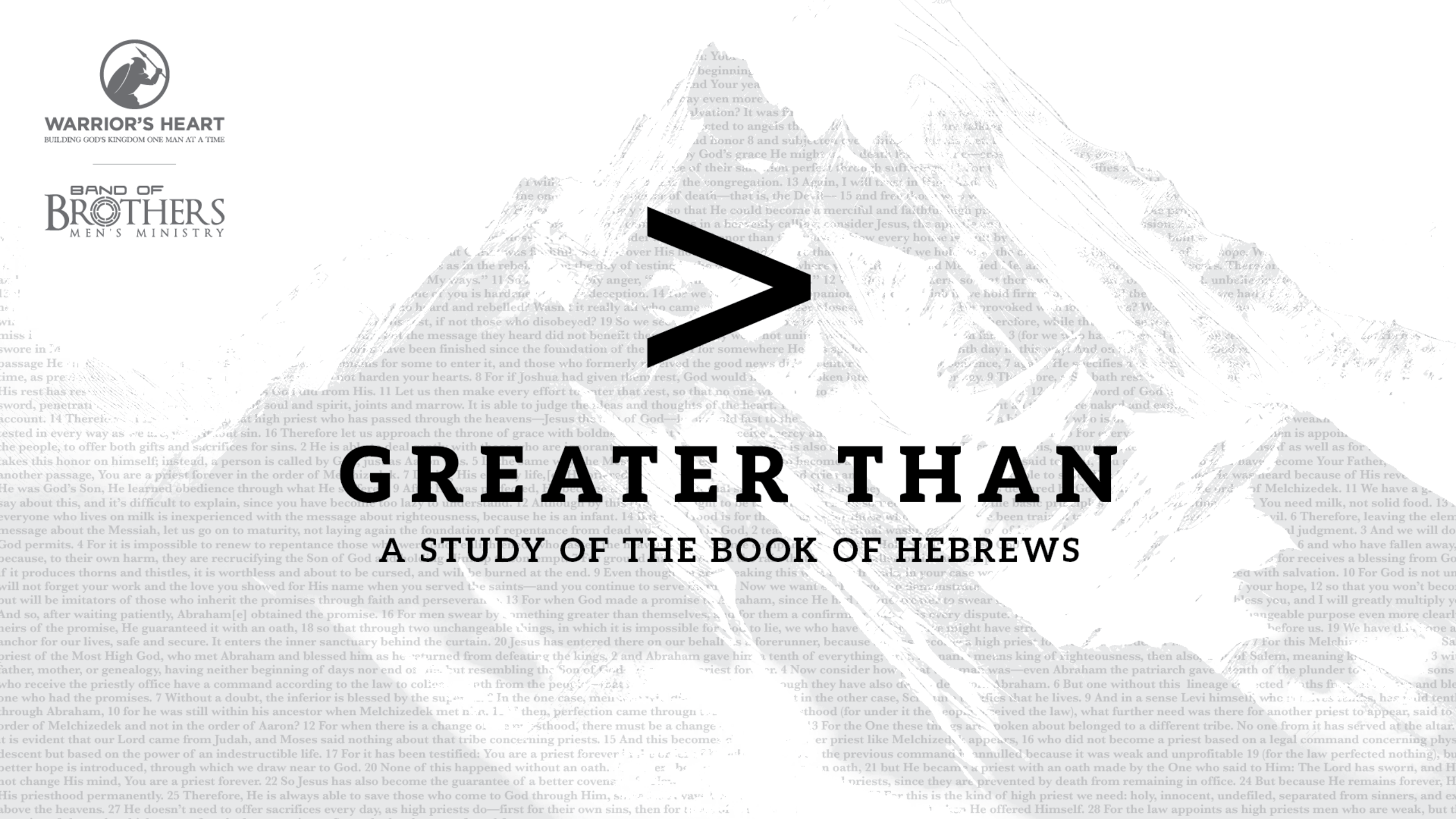

Summarizing Hebrews Chapters 1-12

“In the comparison to EVERYTHING else in the divine plan for creation and redemption, Jesus is superior! Hebrews described the superiority of the new covenant to the old covenant because Hebrews wanted the readers to remember that Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of the law and God’s promises in the O.T. ... Jesus taught that the OT was fulfilled in Himself (Mt 5:17-18) so the author of Hebrews taught that the old covenant has been fulfilled in the new covenant, the new is actually better (Heb 7:22). The New covenant was made superior by the ministry (gospel) of Jesus Christ.” [Holman Study Bible Commentary]

²Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it. ³Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering. ⁴Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral. ⁵Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said,

“Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.” ⁶So we say with confidence,

“The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?”

⁷Remember your leaders who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith.
