

Colossians 2:4-10

⁴ I am saying this so that no one will deceive you with arguments that sound reasonable. 5 For I may be absent in body, but I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see how well ordered you are and the strength of your faith in Christ. 6 So then, just as you have received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to walk in him, ⁷ being rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude.

Pastoral Concerns

- Paul is protective of the spiritual health of the church.
 - Satan is deceptive
 - Satan will distract us
 - If we zero in on specifics we miss the whole truth
 - a whole truth with a little lie is a falsehood
- Paul is saying it may sound reasonable but something about it stinks
- Verse 5: Paul's heart is with the church, he is praying for them and encouraging them to pursue and know the real Christ
