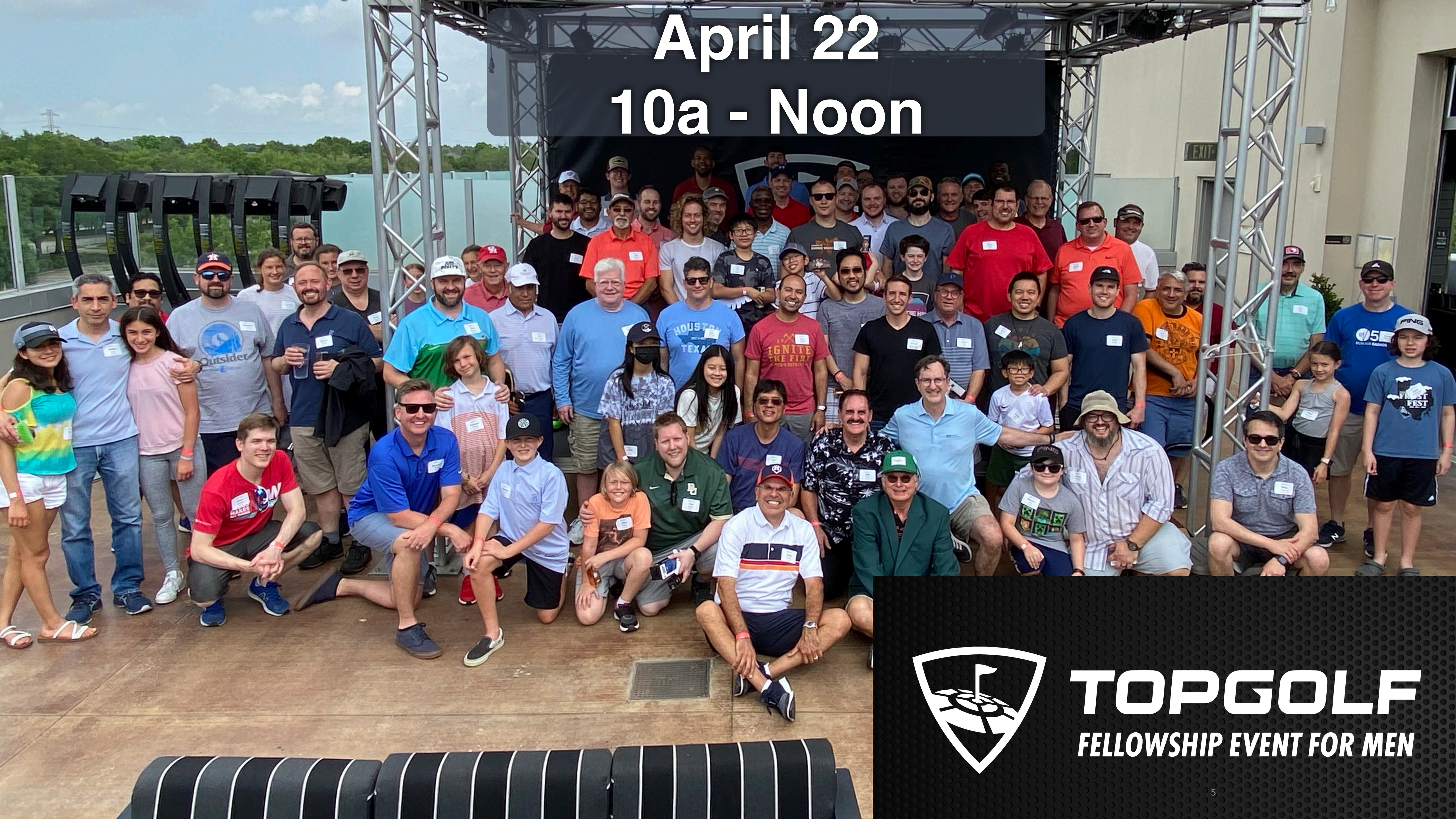

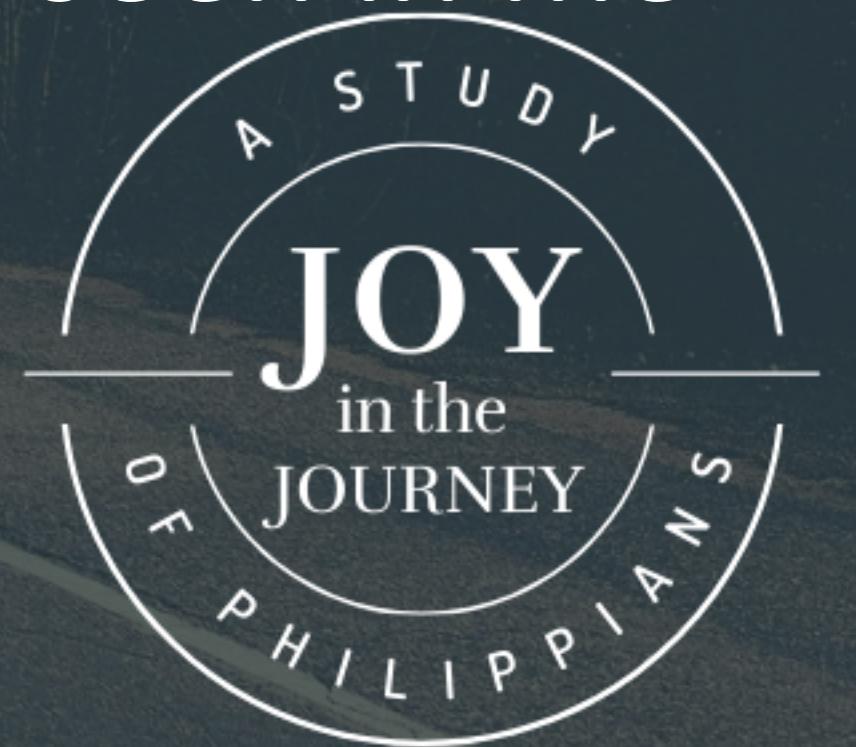

Principle

Main Truth:

To have the peace OF God, you must KNOW the God of peace.

To have the peace OF God, you must have peace WITH God by KNOWING the God of peace.
