If We Only Knew Ephesians 2: 1 - 7

Background

- Ephesians was written by the Apostle Paul one of his "Prison Epistles"
- Paul is now 60 years old 25+ years since his road to Damascus encounter (Acts 9)
- Has more Missionary Frequent Traveler Miles than any of us
- Started the Ephesian church ~ 7 years ago
- Written to Believers in Christ

Ephesians 1, v 15 - 23

Paul's Personal Encouragement to the Ephesian church (and Us!)

...That incomparably great power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ GOD exerted when GOD raised Christ from the dead and **Christ's Power for the** heavenly ower and dominion, **Faithful** ower and only in the present age but also in the one to come. (Ephesians 1: 19 – 21 NIV)






