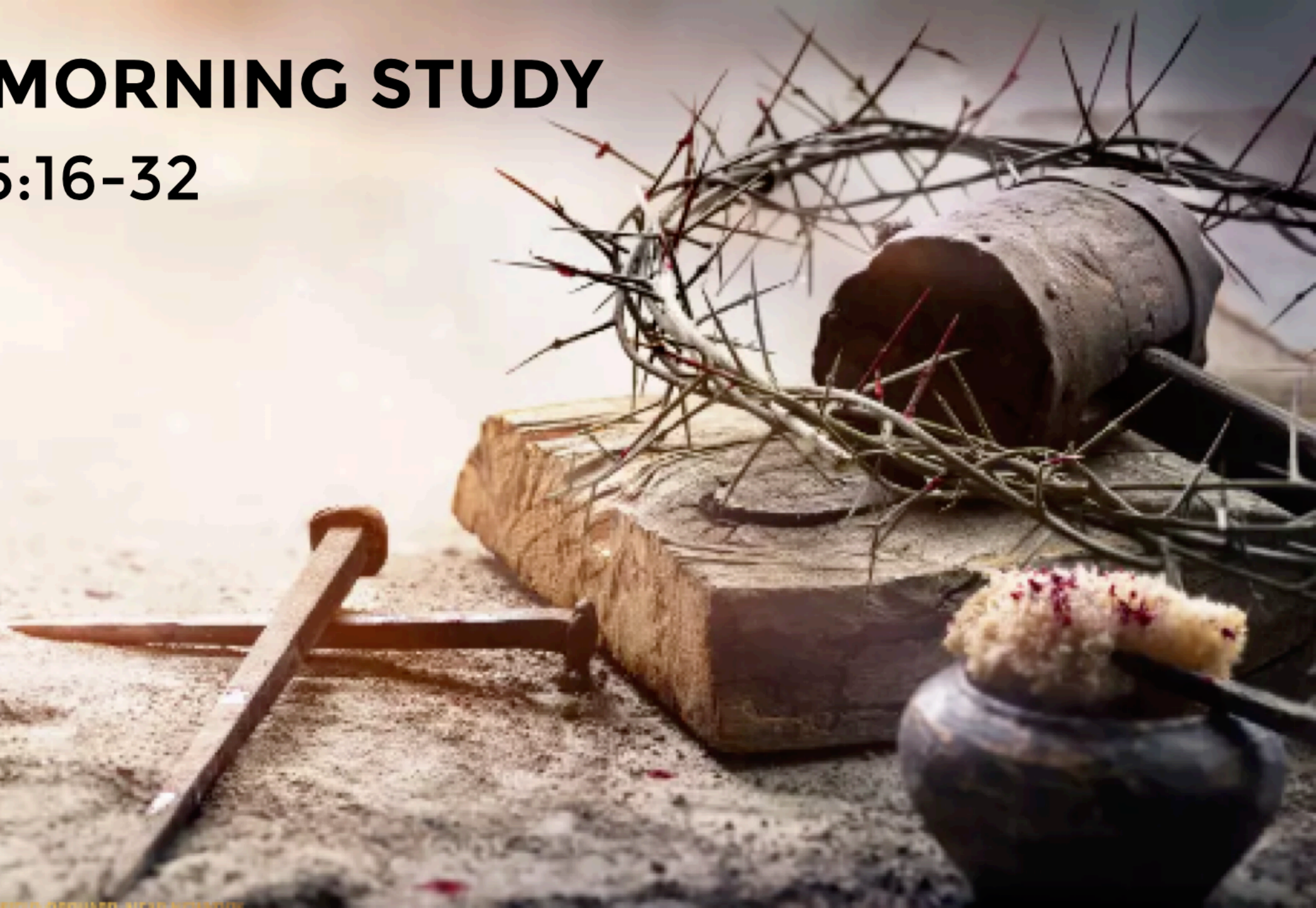

Mark 15:16-20



¹⁶ Then the soldiers led Him away into the courtyard (that is, headquarters) and called the whole company together.

¹⁷ They dressed Him in a purple robe, twisted together a crown of thorns, and put it on Him. ¹⁸ And they began to salute Him, “Hail, King of the Jews!” ¹⁹ They kept hitting Him on the head with a reed and spitting on Him. Getting down on their knees, they were paying Him homage.

²⁰ When they had mocked Him, they stripped Him of the purple robe, put His clothes on Him, and led Him out to crucify Him.

Mark 15:21-26



²¹ They forced a man coming in from the country, who was passing by, to carry Jesus' cross. He was Simon, a Cyrenian, the father of Alexander and Rufus. ²² And they brought Jesus to the place called *Golgotha* (which means Skull Place). ²³ They tried to give Him wine mixed with myrrh, but He did not take it. ²⁴ Then they crucified Him and divided His clothes, casting lots for them to decide what each would get. ²⁵ Now it was nine in the morning when they crucified Him. ²⁶ The inscription of the charge written against Him was: **THE KING OF THE JEWS.**

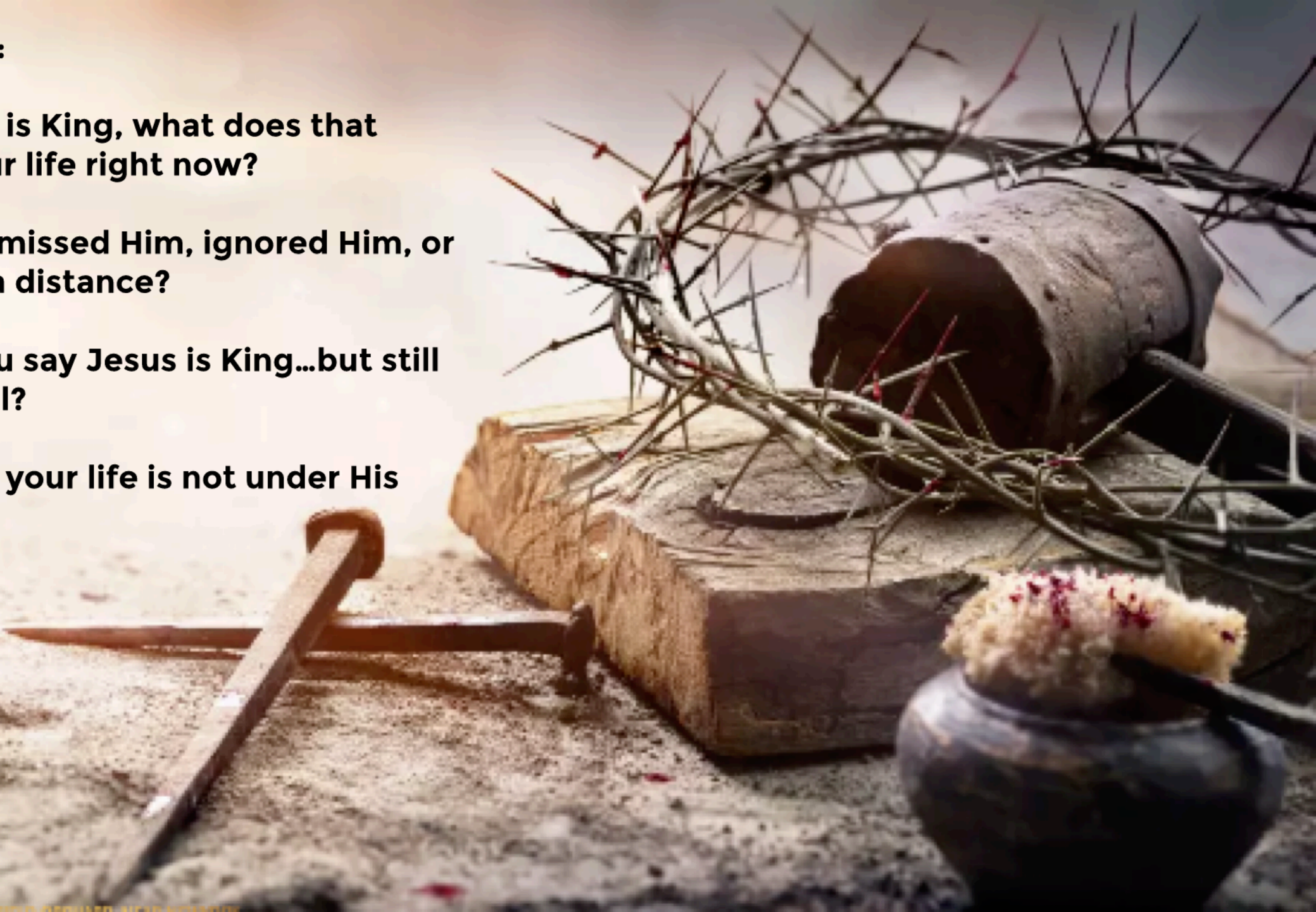
²⁷ They crucified two criminals with Him, one on His right and one on His left. [²⁸ So the Scripture was fulfilled that says: **And He was counted among outlaws.**] ²⁹ Those who passed by were yelling insults at Him, shaking their heads, and saying, “Ha! The One who would demolish the sanctuary and build it in three days, ³⁰ save Yourself by coming down from the cross!” ³¹ In the same way, the chief priests with the scribes were mocking Him to one another and saying, “He saved others; He cannot save Himself! ³² Let the Messiah, the King of Israel, come down now from the cross, so that we may see and believe.” Even those who were crucified with Him were taunting Him.

1. THE MOCKED KING

- **What area of your life is not under His authority?**

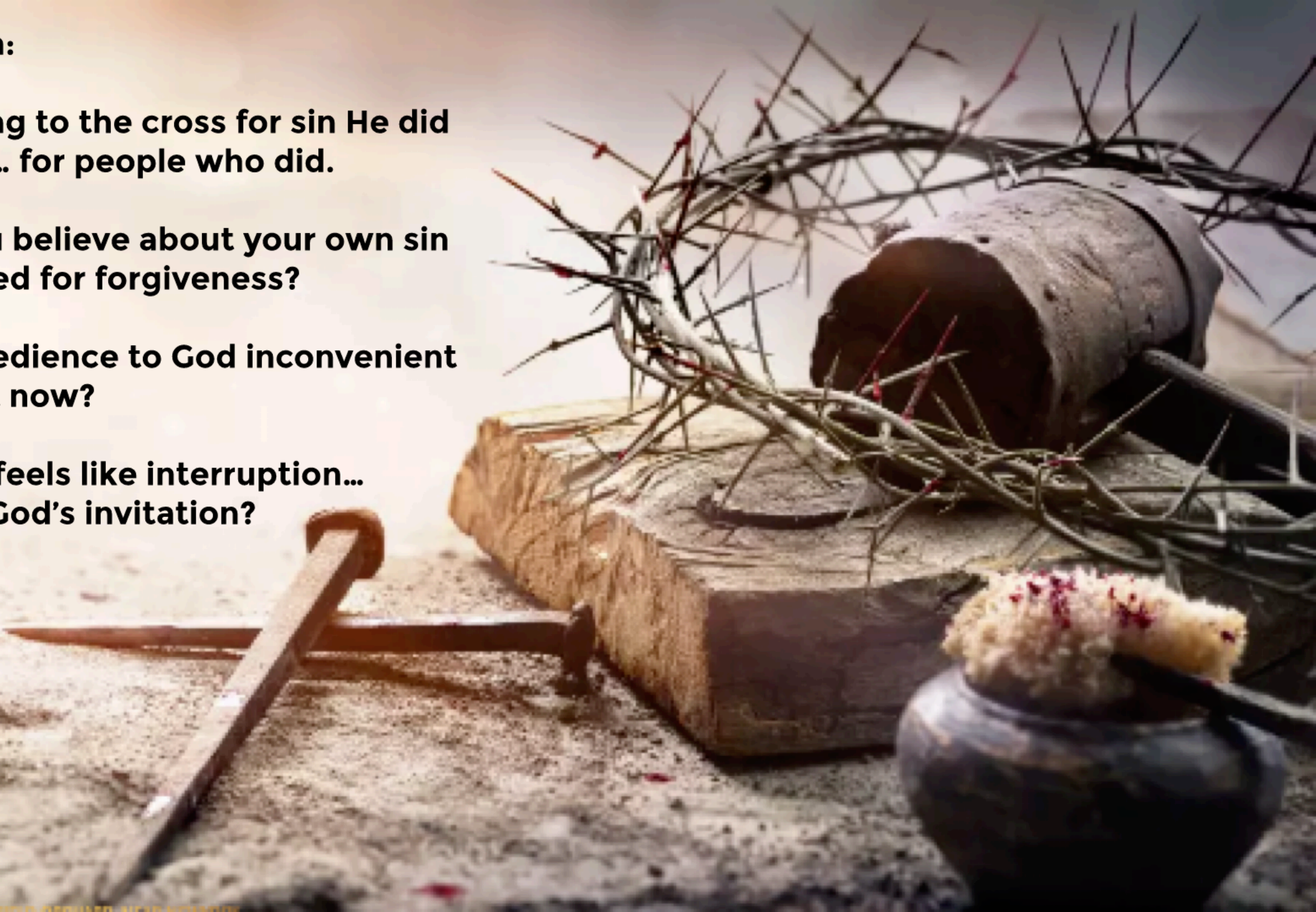


2. THE BURDEN-BEARING KING



Table Discussion:

- **Jesus is going to the cross for sin He did not commit... for people who did.**
- **What do you believe about your own sin and your need for forgiveness?**
- **Where is obedience to God inconvenient for you right now?**
- **Could what feels like interruption... actually be God's invitation?**

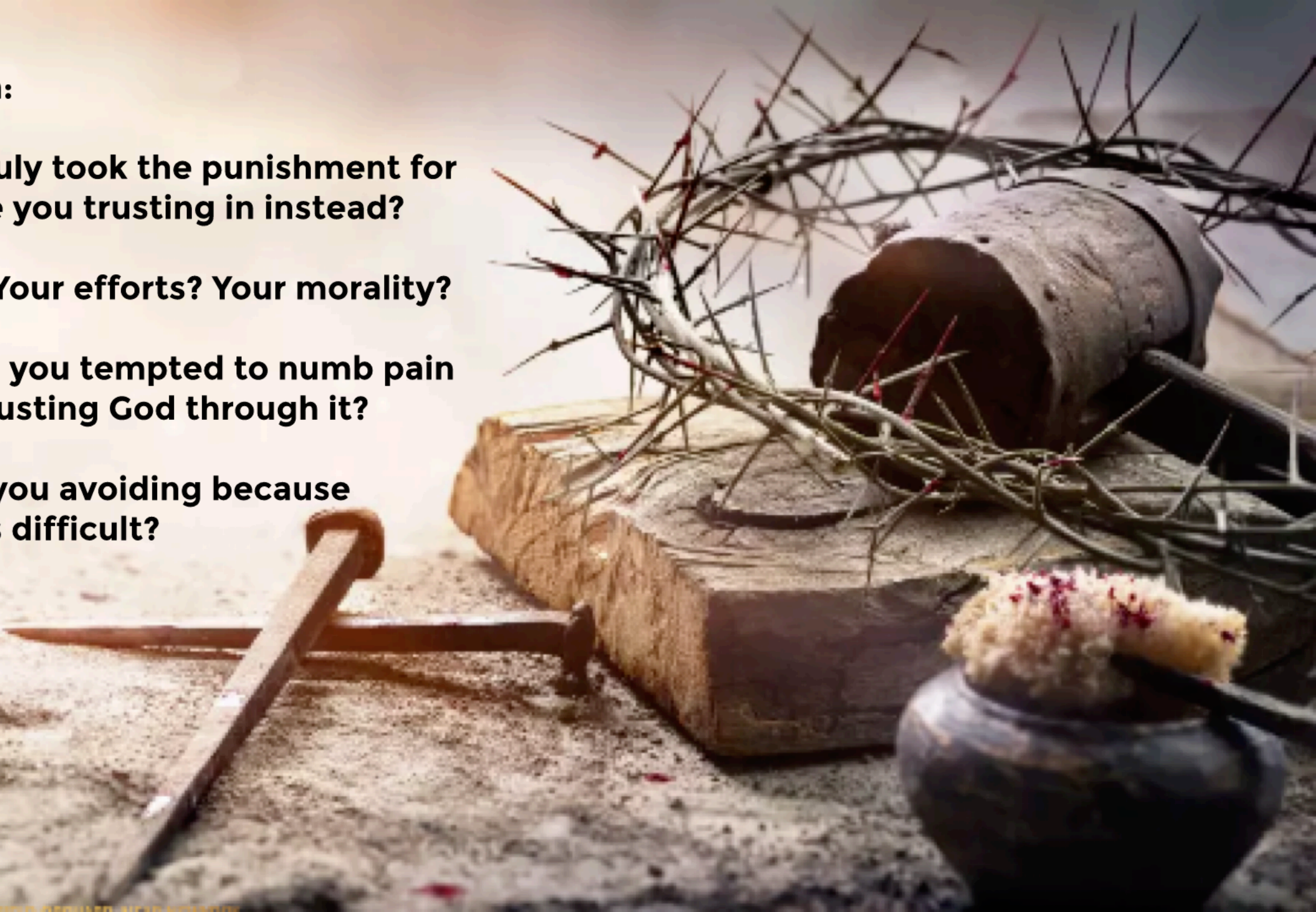


3. THE CRUCIFIED KING



Table Discussion:

- ++If Jesus truly took the punishment for sin, what are you trusting in instead?
- ++Yourself? Your efforts? Your morality?
- ++Where are you tempted to numb pain instead of trusting God through it?
- ++What are you avoiding because obedience is difficult?

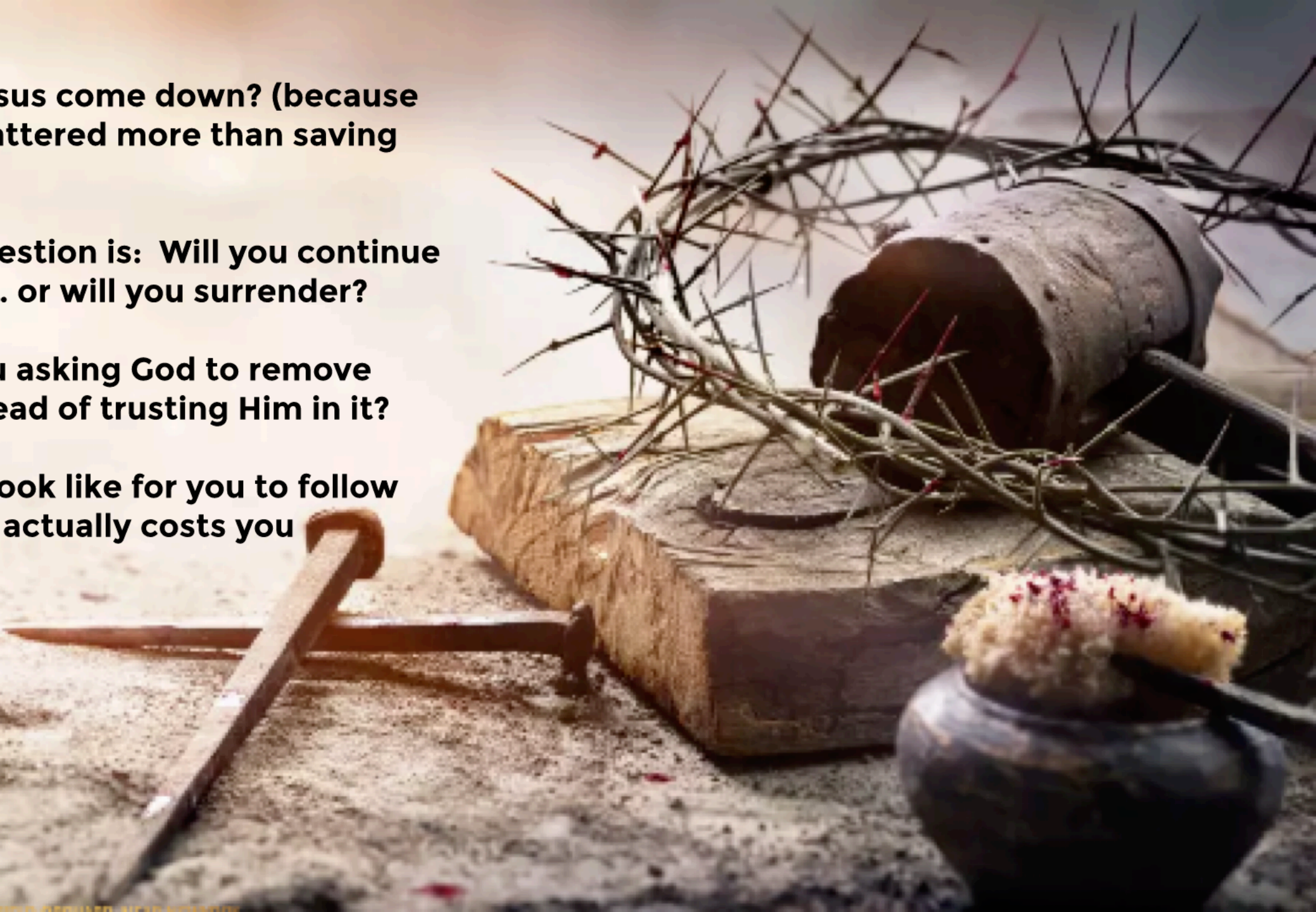


4. THE REJECTED KING



Table Discussion:

- **Why didn't Jesus come down? (because saving you mattered more than saving Himself)**
- **So the real question is: Will you continue to reject Him... or will you surrender?**
- **Where are you asking God to remove difficulty instead of trusting Him in it?**
- **What does it look like for you to follow Jesus when it actually costs you something?**



Mark 15:1-15



- Verse 1-5: Jesus, God Himself, temporarily humbled before a temporarily exalted sinner in Pontius Pilate, so that one day humbled sinners, in you and me, would be able to stand before an eternally exalted God
- Verse 6-15: Jesus replaces Barabbas, the guilty man freed by the sacrifice of the innocent.

1. How often do you comfort yourself with the good news that Jesus died for your sins?
2. Do you remember well that the foundation of your Christian life is the gospel? Rate yourself on a scale from 1-10?
