Biblical UN-Leaders

- > Genesis 6 [the people of Noah's days] <u>Believing</u> God requires a teachable heart to see God in [others' works].
- > Exodus 7-14 [Pharaoh] <u>Pride</u> is unacceptable within God's will and brings a man to brokenness and [defeat by an <u>unteachable</u> <u>spirit</u>.
- Leviticus 10:1-3 [Nadab & Abihu] Adding to the <u>Scriptures</u> can lead into <u>unacceptable</u> circumstances; take the inerrant Word to heart.
- I Samuel 25 [Nabal] When God sends kind messengers to you, be <u>aware</u> (teachable) that they are of God ... repent as is necessary, and return kindness give the trouble to the Lord, because <u>vengeance</u> is His work to do.

Biblical UN-Leaders (continued)

- Luke 23:1-23 [Pontius Pilate & King Herod] Men can easily break from accountability and be swayed to fall to the lies of the day or the crowd; listen for your <u>Father's</u> voice for the Truth!
- Luke 6:16, 22:3-53; Acts 1:15-26 [Judas Iscariot] There are <u>consequences</u> for having knowledge of the right things of God but not acting on them <u>rightly</u>.
- > 3 John 9-10 [Diotrephes] God <u>calls</u> His leaders and <u>prepares</u> them for leading.

Character of an UN-Leader

If we're trying hard to fix the flesh we'll assuredly slide the scales toward UN-Leader.

- **➤**Squinting eyes and muffed ears ...
 - There'd be little motive to read the Word
 - No reason to listen to a brother, a preacher, a teacher Isaiah 30:20-21
 - No reason to "do as the Word says" James
 - There'd be no trials presented to him "take joy in your trials" **James**
 - Would listen to others more than to God (minimal prayer; not in Scripture)
- > Cool, or even cold and hard heart ...
 - might be taking conversations and accusations personally, being often offended and walking away from people not seeking the truth
 - may be defensive in arguments, maybe raising the voice and overtalking the person on the opposing side
 - may be silent on the issues



Biblical Godly Leaders

Good leaders are good [listeners]; servant-leaders are observant [followers]; these are character cornerstones of FULL-ON [believers].

- > Genesis 6-9 [Noah, His Wife and 3 Sons]
- ➤ Genesis 12-19 [Abraham]
