WEEK 3: THE LAST DAYS



October 3, 2021

Confronting the debilitating doom and gloom prophecy profiteers is nothing new, even though it might be new to us.

"It is evident that... every form of worship will be destroyed except the religion of Christ, which will alone prevail. And indeed it will one day triumph, as its principles take possession of the minds of men <u>more and more every day.</u>" - Origen of Alexandria (influential church father who lived from 185-254 AD):

<u>1 Corinthians 15:22–26</u> - For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. ²³ But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. ²⁴ Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father <u>after destroying every rule and every authority and power.</u> ²⁵ For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. ²⁶ The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

What's the order of events in this passage?

- 1. Jesus Christ is reigning NOW
- 2. He is putting all His enemies under His feet
- 3. Jesus returns as victorious conqueror
- 4. Those who belong to Christ are "made alive" (resurrected)
- 5. Death (the final enemy) is defeated
- 6. Victorious Jesus turns His conquered Kingdom over to the Father and submits Himself to the Father's theocratic rule

If God teaches in the Bible that the Gospel will be victorious before King Jesus's "Second Coming", why do many people believe that the world will get worse and worse before Jesus returns?

- 1. People think "the Great Tribulation" is still in our future (we'll talk about this next week)
- 2. People think the "Last Days" are still in our future... and that's not a pretty picture

<u>2 Timothy 3:1–9</u> - But understand this, that <u>in the last days</u> there will come times of difficulty. ² For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³ heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, ⁴ treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people. ⁶ For among them are those who creep into households and capture weak women, burdened with sins and led astray by various passions, ⁷ always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth. ⁸ Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith. ⁹ But they will not get very far, for their folly will be plain to all, as was that of those two men. (see also 1 Timothy 4:1–2 and Jude 17–19)

How could the "last days" possibly be in our past?!?!? We only need to take the time texts of the Bible literally*

<u>1 Peter 1:20</u> - [Christ] was foreknown before the foundation of the world but <u>was made manifest in</u> <u>the last times</u> for the sake of you

<u>1 Corinthians 10:11</u> - Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, <u>on whom the end of the ages has come</u>.

<u>Hebrews 1:1–2</u> - Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, ² but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

<u>1 John 2:18</u> - Children, <u>it is the last hour</u>, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come. Therefore <u>we know that it is the last hour</u>.

<u>James 5:1–3</u> - Come now, you rich, weep and howl for the miseries that are coming upon you. ² Your riches have rotted and your garments are moth-eaten. ³ Your gold and silver have corroded, and their corrosion will be evidence against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have laid up treasure <u>in the last days</u>.

According to the Bible, the last days (notice the plural) were when the end of the old covenant came in the first century. The last days were the period between Jesus' resurrection (~30 AD) and the destruction of Jerusalem and the Old Covenant Temple (70 AD)

Acts 2:15–21 - For these people are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. ¹⁶ But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel: ¹⁷ "And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; ¹⁸ even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy. ¹⁹ And I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and vapor of smoke; ²⁰ the sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the day of the Lord comes, the great and magnificent day. ²¹ And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.'

While the last days are behind us, THE LAST DAY is still following the future resurrection that occurs at the bodily return of Jesus Christ (see <u>1 Corinthians</u> <u>15:22-26</u> above)

<u>1 Corinthians 15:50–58</u> - I tell you this, brothers: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. ⁵¹ Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. ⁵³ For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. ⁵⁴ When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory." ⁵⁵ "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?" ⁵⁶ The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. ⁵⁷ But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁵⁸ Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

<u>1 Corinthians 3:11–15</u> - For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw— ¹³ each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. ¹⁴ If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

<u>Hebrews 10:24–25</u> - And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more <u>as you see the Day drawing near</u>.
