READ Psalm 23 together with your family.

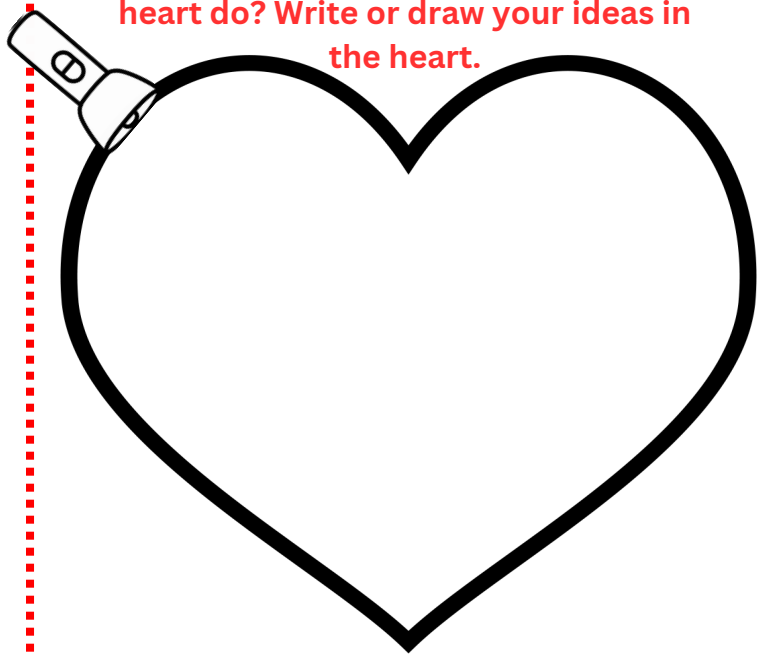
David trusted God because he knew who God was. He called God his Shepherd — the One who provides, protects, and guides him.
