for I have not found your works complete in the sight of my God. ³ Remember, then, what you received and heard. Keep it, and repent. If you will not wake up, <u>I will come like a thief</u>, and you will not know at what hour <u>I will come against you</u>." (See also <u>Revelation 2:5</u>, <u>16</u>)

The Bible uses the same kind of language for the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 AD by the Romans as it used about the destruction of the First Temple by the Babylonians in the 6th century BC.

Prophecy before the Second Temple was destroyed by Romans in 70 AD:

<u>Matthew 24:21</u> - For then there will be great tribulation, such as <u>has not been from the beginning</u> of the world until now, no, and <u>never will be</u>.

Prophecy before the First Temple Destroyed by Babylonians in the sixth century BC:

<u>Ezekiel 5:9</u> - And because of all your abominations I will do with you <u>what I have never</u> <u>yet done</u>, and the like of which <u>I will never do again</u>. (see also <u>Daniel 9:12</u>)

So why does this matter?

Just like failed prophecies would undermine the reliability of the Bible, fulfilled prophecies confirm it

<u>Isaiah 46:9a–10</u> - I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, ¹⁰ declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and <u>I will accomplish all my purpose</u>,'

God has already judged the path of disobedience and its end is destruction

<u>Philippians 3:18–19</u> - For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you <u>even with tears</u>, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. ¹⁹ <u>Their end is destruction</u>, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things.

<u>Proverbs 1:7</u> - Fear of Yahweh is the beginning of knowledge; wisdom and instruction, fools despise.

God has promised to bless the path of obedience

<u>Isaiah 30:18, 26</u> - Therefore Yahweh waits to be gracious to you, and therefore he will rise up to show you mercy, for Yahweh is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for him.... ²⁶ And <u>the light of the full moon</u> will be like the light of the sun, and <u>the light of the sun will be sevenfold</u>, like <u>the light of seven days</u>, on the day when Yahweh binds up the breakage of his people, and he heals the wound of his blow. (see also <u>Isaiah 60:20</u>)

<u>Acts 5:32</u> - And we are witnesses to these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him.

<u>Proverbs 15:29</u> - Yahweh is far from the wicked, but <u>the prayers of the righteous he will hear.</u>

<u>Hebrews 5:9</u> - And being made perfect, he became the source of eternal <u>salvation to all</u> who obey him

WEEK 5: PROPHECY FAILED OR FULFILLED?

October 17, 2021

Matthew 24:29–35 - "And immediately after the tribulation of those days. 'the sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of heaven will be shaken.' 30 And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man arriving on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. 31 And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect together from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other end of it. 32 Now learn the parable from the fig tree: Whenever its branch has already become tender and puts forth its leaves, you know that summer is near. 33 So also you, when you see all these things, know that he is near, at the door. 34 Truly I say to you that this generation will never pass away until all these things take place! 35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away."

What happens when you interpret the Bible "literally", instead of interpreting the Bible the way the Bible interprets itself?

"But there is worse to come. 'Say what you like,' we shall be told, 'the apocalyptic beliefs of the first Christians have been proved to be false. It is clear from the New Testament that they all expected the Second Coming in their own lifetime. And, worse still, they had a reason, and one which you will find very embarrassing. Their Master had told them so. He shared, and indeed created, their delusion. He said in so many words, "this generation shall not pass till all these things be done." And He was wrong. He clearly knew no more about the end of the world than anyone else.' It is certainly the most embarrassing verse in the Bible." - C. S. Lewis.

Matthew 24:3-35 describes another "judgement Coming" not the Second Coming (*Genesis 11:5*; *Exodus 3:8, 19:9, 34:5*; *Psalm 18:6–17*; *Isaiah 19:1–4, 31:4*; *Micah 1:3–5*).

Old Testament example: Lights Out for Babylon

<u>Isaiah 13:6–11</u> - Wail, for the day of Yahweh is near; <u>it will come</u> like destruction from Shaddai!

⁷ Therefore all hands will grow slack, and every human heart will melt, ⁸ and they will be dismayed. Pangs and labor pains will seize them; they will tremble like a woman giving birth. They will stare at one another, their faces flushing. ⁹ Look! <u>The day of Yahweh is coming</u>, cruel and wrath and the burning of anger, to make the earth a desolation, and he will destroy its sinners from it. ¹⁰ For <u>the stars of the heavens and their constellations will not flash forth their light; the sun will keep back when it comes out, and the moon will not cause its light to shine.

¹¹ And I will punish the world for its evil and the wicked for their iniquity. And I will put an end to the pride of the arrogant, and I will bring the haughtiness of tyrants low.</u>

Lights Out for Egypt - <u>Ezekiel 32:7-8</u> Lights Out for Israel (Northern Kingdoms) - <u>Amos 5:18-20</u> Lights Out for Judah (Southern Kingdom) - <u>Joel 2:10</u>

The New Testament also has "Judgment Comings" that are NOT the Second Coming

<u>Revelation 3:1–3</u> - "And to the angel of the church in Sardis write: 'The words of him who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. "I know your works. You have the reputation of being alive, but you are dead. ² Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is about to die,
