Discuss traits you see as reflecting a healthy character.

Discuss these statements:

2. How does being a servant interact with our character development?
3. Are there ways that your character sabotages your anointing?
4. In what ways does your current lifestyle reflect Kingdom character?
5. We have the authority to leave a legacy of life and death, we seek to develop awareness of royalty in ourselves as well as those around us. How do you use God’s favor and your influence to further the Kingdom of God?
