Tonight's Focus: Catalyst

What does it mean to be a catalyst? By definition a catalyst is a person or thing that precipitates an event; a substance that increases the rate of a chemical reaction without itself undergoing any permanent chemical change.

In our Tribe culture, to be a catalyst is to be a change agent. As catalysts we have the opportunity to live as forerunners, releasing fresh innovation and bringing heaven to earth.

Philippians 2:14-15

“Do everything readily and cheerfully - no bickering, no second guessing allowed! Go out into the world uncorrupted, a breath of fresh air in this squalid and polluted society. Provide people with a glimpse of good living and of the living God.”

Discussion Questions:

1. How has the environment of catalytic thinkers and innovators influenced you since coming to Eagle Mountain?
2. In the teaching, Bobby says catalysts are more afraid of staying in the boat and missing out. How is your mindset wired right now? Are you seeking new ways to step out, or do you prefer to stay in the boat? There is no right or wrong, just where you are in your process.

3. Bobby sees a catalyst in you... in what areas are you feeling pulled or inspired to step out and take risks differently?

The 7 C's Conclusion

Discussion Questions:

1. Is there a specific C that you feel the Lord is highlighting to you to grow in?
2. What are some ways you can commit to growing in the 7C's? How will it look in your daily living?
3. What are some ways we can keep the 7C's in our daily language?
