The Tongue

James 3:3-12

*3 When we put bits into the mouths of horses to make them obey us, we can turn the whole animal. 4 Or take ships as an example. Although they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are steered by a very small rudder wherever the pilot wants to go. 5 Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts. Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark. 6 The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell. 7 All kinds of animals, birds, reptiles and sea creatures are being tamed and have been tamed by mankind, 8 but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. 9 With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse human beings, who have been made in God's likeness. 10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers and sisters, **this should not be.** 11 Can both fresh water and salt water flow from the same spring? 12 My brothers and sisters, can a fig tree bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Neither can a salt spring produce fresh water.*

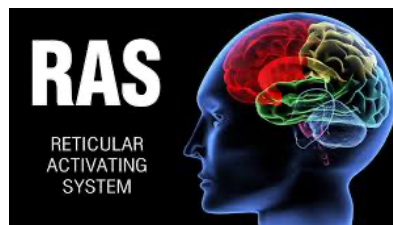

- What happens when the RAS is not working right?
 - We are physically _____, but not focused or alert.
 - Our sleep is disrupted; and we awaken more “tired” than rested. Sleep loses its restorative power.
 - Our ability to _____ is curtailed.
 - If our “filter or gatekeeper” is overwhelmed; those little things that we have properly ignored will clamor for our attention, much like a crying two-year-old, causing us to miss out on what is really important.

- Fear, danger, pain, & noxious experiences will trigger a real response of adrenaline, raising blood pressure, pulse, and will block the ability to perceive or respond to any other stimulus.

What does a healed RAS look like?

1. Holy Spirit communicates to your RAS what to focus on. You will start to see the kingdom and possess clear vision and purpose.
2. Your mind is used to confirm the greatness of God to you.
3. You find yourself thinking the thoughts of Christ with surety.
4. Confusion and fear lose their power.
5. God can speak to you about higher things because your filter has a grid for it. Your faith level is congruent with the spirit of your mind.
6. Your dream life and innovation continue to multiply and confirm God's will for your life.
